- **22** I will save my flock, they shall no longer be a prey; and I will judge between sheep and sheep.
- **23** And I will set up over them one shepherd, my servant David, and he shall feed them: he shall feed them and be their shepherd.
- **24** And I, the Lord, will be their God, and my servant David shall be prince among them; I, the Lord, have spoken.

Luke 17: 11-19

- **11** On the way to Jerusalem he was passing along between Samaria and Galilee.
- **12** And as he entered a village, he was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance
- **13** and lifted up their voices and said, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us."
- **14** When he saw them he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went they were cleansed.
- **15** Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice;

The purpose is to make our faith community welcoming and inclusive of everyone into all aspects of the life of the church. The audit is a guide which helps to determine what work has already been done and what areas need to be improved. It was not an all-inclusive list and some items do not apply to our setting. This topic was brought to consistory and Amanda Custer has volunteered to head up the

process along with the property committee. There are goals to be completed within the next year, 3 years, and 5 years.
