### **The Hebrew Scripture Lesson is from Isaiah Chapter 42, vs 1-9**

**1** Behold my servant, whom I uphold,  
my chosen, in whom my soul delights;  
I have put my Spirit upon him,  
he will bring forth justice to the nations.

**2** He will not cry or lift up his voice,  
or make it heard in the street;  
**3** a bruised reed he will not break,  
and a dimly burning wick he will not quench;  
he will faithfully bring forth justice.

**4** He will not fail or be discouraged  
till he has established justice in the earth;  
and the coastlands wait for his law.

**5** Thus says God, the Lord,  
who created the heavens and stretched them out,  
who spread forth the earth and what comes from it,  
who gives breath to the people upon it  
and spirit to those who walk in it:

**6** "I am the Lord, I have called you in righteousness,  
I have taken you by the hand and kept you;  
I have given you as a covenant to the people,  
a light to the nations,

**7** to open the eyes that are blind,  
to bring out the prisoners from the dungeon,  
from the prison those who sit in darkness.

**8** I am the Lord, that is my name;  
my glory I give to no other,  
nor my praise to graven images.

**9** Behold, the former things have come to pass,  
and new things I now declare;  
before they spring forth  
I tell you of them."

**The Gospel of Jesus Christ is from  
Matthew Chapter 3, vs 13-17**

**13** Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to John, to be baptized by him.

**14** John would have prevented him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?"

**15** But Jesus answered him, "Let it be so now; for thus it is fitting for us to fulfil all righteousness." Then he consented.

**16** And when Jesus was baptized, he went up immediately from the water, and behold, the heavens were opened and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and alighting on him;

**17** and lo, a voice from heaven, saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

**A reading from the book of ACTS Chapter 10, 34-43.**

**34** And Peter opened his mouth and said: "Truly I perceive that God shows no partiality,

**35** but in every nation any one who fears him and does what is right is acceptable to him.

**36** You know the word which he sent to Israel, preaching good news of peace by Jesus Christ (he is Lord of all),

**37** the word which was proclaimed throughout all Judea, beginning from Galilee after the baptism which John preached:

**38** how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power; how he went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed by the devil, for God was with him.

**39** And we are witnesses to all that he did both in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They put him to death by hanging him on a tree;

**40** but God raised him on the third day and made him manifest;

**41** not to all the people but to us who were chosen by God as witnesses, who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.

**42** And he commanded us to preach to the people, and to testify that he is the one ordained by God to be judge of the living and the dead.

**43** To him all the prophets bear witness that every one who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.”

**Save Your Valentine.** On February 21, 2026, the Berlin Lions Club and Red Cross will be providing a free training class on performing CPR, giving First Aid and how to operate an AED (Automatic External Defibrillator) unit. The training, which includes hands-on introduction, will be held in the Borough Building, with check-in between 8:00 and 8:30 AM. Your Berlin Lion's club has provided over 30 AED units throughout our community. Statistics show that the immediate use, by bystanders, of an AED potentially raises the survival rate from 60 to 90% compared to just 5 to 7% when waiting only for EMS. Our church has an AED in the 1st floor activities room. The session lasts 3 to 4 hours; refreshments will be provided. 
