March 13, 2022***

Confession, Word and Morning Prayer

Welcome to Trinity Church. . .

This is the Second Sunday in Lent as we journey to the celebration of the Resurrection. This year we are making this journey as we hear from the psalms. Given all of the turmoil in the world today, we will hear the promises of protection, peace, and purpose for life.

This morning we turn to Psalm 27 which is one of the best known and most comforting psalms in the Psalter. It is hard to know whether it is chiefly a psalm of confidence, written against the dark background of David's many enemies, or chiefly a lament in which David cries out for help against implacable foes. The reason for the confusion is obvious. The first half of the psalm [vs. 1-6] exudes confidence. The second half [vs. 7-14] is a very moving prayer.

The late Dr. James Boice writes: *What we have here is an unfolding of two closely related moods by the same inspired author, put together like two movements of a symphony. And the point is that these two apparently opposing moods are also often in us, frequently at the same time or at nearly the same time. Don't you find you are often both confident and anxious, trusting and fearful, or at least that your mood swings easily from one to the other? I do. It is part of what it means to be a weak human being.*

Since that is true of us, it should be a comfort to realize that it was also true of David.

The gospel lesson this morning is from St. Luke 13:31-35. I believe there is a word to a world leader here this morning. "Go tell that fox" – this is the only time Jesus treats someone with contempt. When Jesus would later stand before "the fox" [Herod], he would say nothing at all, against showing contempt for him. As Leon Morris has remarked *when Jesus has nothing to say to a man that man's position is hopeless. Herod was a dead man in every way.*


