Remembrance of Baptism

Brothers and sisters in Christ,
we are united by a common faith in Jesus Christ.
The power at work in this community
does not come from our own strength
but from God’s Spirit working in us.
Claiming God’s promises,
we remember again God’s gracious love for us
and recommit ourselves to joyful life together in Christ.

Hear again the gracious promises of God, and know that all of
God’s promises are brought to completion through Jesus Christ!

*If Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin,
the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you,
he who raised Christ from the dead will give life
to your mortal bodies also through his Spirit that dwells in you.
So then, brothers and sisters,
we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh—
for if you live according to the flesh, you will die;
but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will
live. For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.

Do you renounce all sinful desires that draw you from the love of God?

I renounce them!

Do you turn to Jesus Christ?

Yes! I trust in him as my Lord and Savior.

Do you intend to be Christ's faithful disciple, trusting his promises, obeying his Word, honoring his church, and showing his love, as long as you live?

Yes! God helping me.

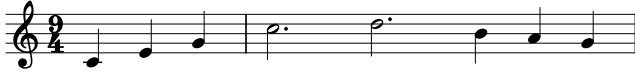

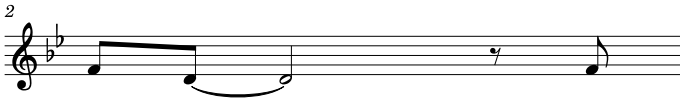
